Dear Board Members, Journal of Illinois History:

My representative in the Illinois General Assembly got the name of Ms. Hogan, Director of Governmental & Legislative Affairs, Illinois Historic Preservation Agency, who said you, The Editorial Board, were responsible for determining plagiarism.

Dr. Tubbs, editor of the Journal of Illinois History ignored 3 or 4 inquires I made to him about plagiarism issues.

Ms Hogan instructed, present "the plagiarized section and compare it with the original to demonstrate without a shadow of a doubt the work was unattributed."

On Jan. 26, I sent you a sworn notarized affidavit demonstrating the plagiarized sections. I have not heard from even one of you regarding this clear case of plagiarized material as it appeared in "Validating the 1673 Marquette Map" in the Journal of Illinois History Vol. 14 (Winter 2011).
